Old Business:

3. Concerts in this new format were a success! We had many families join us outside, socially distanced for the concert as well as many views on the live stream posted on Facebook. Our May concert will be in similar format.

Treasurer Report:

1. Fair Share - We still have some Fair Share payments coming in from students in band and we also received payments from the Winter Guard.

1. Fundraising

A. We are in need of a Concessions Chair for next year. We need to begin ordering food supplies for next year.

- B. We are looking at purchasing a portable deep fryer to use next year in concessions. We had much success with the sale of french fries at our games.
- C. Car washes at the 5/3rd bank are on hold until we have received permission from the school/county due to Covid restrictions.

- 2. There will be a Spring Concert either May 14th or May 21st, depending on the testing schedule. We will let everyone know the actual date as soon as we are given notice. It will be in similar format at the MPA concert, outside, socially distanced, and families welcome.

New Business:

- 4. We received Covid rules and procedures from Eckerd Hall, but we have decided to roll over our deposit for next year. The Band Banquet will be held at an outdoor location, possibly at Safety Harbor Waterfront park. We need to decide if we will have "catered" meals brought in.
- 5. Our next board meeting will be held in person at the school. It will be April 26th.
- 6. Solo and Ensemble is April 16th and 17th. Students may record their audition with accompaniment before their allotted time or may perform it at the school (which may be via Zoom with the adjudicator).
