





DO support all the bands. Applaud or even cheer any band when you appreciate something they do.

DO visit the concession stand. A marching competition is also a fundraiser.

DO keep talking to a minimum during a performance. Be respectful of other spectators and hopefully they will extend you the same courtesy.

DO NOT leave or enter the stadium while a band is performing. There should be 5 minutes or more between bands to leave or enter the seating area. In case an emergency arises, please try to leave as quickly and quietly as circumstances allow.

DO set cell phones and pagers to vibrate or turn them off. Cell phone usage or ringing is distracting and breaks the mood of the performance.

DO keep all comments about other bands positive. Students in other bands have worked just as hard as your students and they all deserve our respect.

DO NOT allow children to play in the stands. It is both for their safety and as a courtesy to others that they are not permitted to run up and down steps or play in the aisles.

DO NOT boo other bands or the contest results. Every parent and every band member performing believes their band should be number one. "Winning" is not just first place; it is the state of every individual having endured the hardships, taken the chance of competing and done their personal best in the pursuit of excellence. All our marchers are learning teamwork, respect, pride and the satisfaction that comes from personal effort in pursuit of a goal. There are no losers on the marching field.

DO NOT obstruct the view of others. Please be considerate when using cameras or video recorders.

DO have loads of fun. After all, that is why we are all here, isn't it?

Mr. Smith has designed for several successful drum corps and winter guards in his career including Suncoast Sound, Capital Regiment, Colts, The Company, The Cast, and Seminole World. In 2018, Mr. Smith was inducted into the Florida Federation of Color Guards Hall of Fame.

Mr. Smith, while retired from day to day pageantry instruction, remains busy in the pageantry arts. He is an active marching band adjudicator and clinician for the New York State Field Band Conference and FMBC. He has served on the board of the Florida Federation of Color Guards Circuit and is on the WGI announcing staff for regionals and World Championships.

Currently, Mr. Smith is in his 30th year in public education. He is the AP Human Geography Teacher and Social Studies Department Chair at Seminole High School. 
