Old Business:

Treasurer Report:

1. We're looking good going into the season, but the biggest expenses will be front-loaded at the beginning of the season (band camp, show music, sub-contractors/clinicians)
2. Fair share this year will be \$575, with anyone paying before the August 31st deadline getting two free parent show shirts. Include your shirt sizes in the PayPal or check memo, or e-mail Mrs. Bert
3. Fair share costs go mostly to instruction and transportation

Committee Reports:

1. The Classic Committee has already begun meeting; help if you can!
2. Some school approval was given for fundraising efforts such as car washes. We put in for every Saturday in July at 5/3 Band in the Boot Ranch plaza
3. In November we plan to hold a 5k Your Way event, where you can run, bike or walk. More details forthcoming

1. The band calendar has been updated through November with rehearsals, shows and other events
2. We will be locking in a date for our end of year banquet at Ruth Eckerd Hall

3. The Icebreaker Event is a great way for kids to get together after a tough year, and meet fellow band mates. There will be no playing, just getting to know each other. Emily Sikes will be leading the parent portion of the event
4. Band Camp will be held Monday-Thursday this year from 9am-6pm
 - a. We would need Plant Ops here, but they currently have a 4 day workweek
 - b. Currently trying for schedule change to accommodate the usual Friday parent showcase
5. People need to step up for Fundraising efforts; it takes a village
6. Mr. Black's hip is fine
7. June Rehearsals are on the calendar and are encouraged but optional; we understand that people travel
8. The guidelines for Covid are less stringent this year
 - a. Masks are optional
 - b. There will be time limits for indoor performing
 - c. Thursday Winds rehearsal will be part time outside, with large fans for inside playing portions

New Business:
