He earned his Doctor of Musical Arts degree with an emphasis in Instrumental Conducting from the University of Florida, studying with Dr. David Waybright, Professor Jay Watkins, and Dr. Chip Birkner. Dr. Braue maintains professional memberships with the Tennessee Music Educators Association (TNMEA), the Middle Tennessee School Band and Orchestra Association (MTSBOA), the College Band Directors National Association (CBDNA), and the National Band Association (NBA). He is also a member of numerous honorary organizations, including Pi Kappa Lambda, Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia, Kappa Kappa Psi, Tau Beta Sigma, and Sigma Alpha lota. In addition to his work at the university, Dr. Braue is a nationally recognized clinician, guest conductor, and adjudicator. He resides in the Murfreesboro area with his wife, Michelle, their cat, Nala, and their dog, Maestro.

During his time at Seminole, the band won numerous Outstanding Visual Performance awards at Bands of America and Florida Marching Band Championships competitions.

Mr. Smith has designed for several successful drum corps in his career including DCI Open Class Finalist Suncoast Sound from Tampa Bay, Florida (1994) and the DCI Open Class Silver Medalist Capital Regiment from Columbus, Ohio (2002). Mr. Smith was a visual instructor, drill designer, and staff coordinator for the DCI World Class Finalist Colts Drum and Bugle Corps from Dubuque, Iowa from 1995-2001. In 2017, he rejoined the Colts as a visual staff coordinator. Mr. Smith has instructed at every level of the winter guard activity. He was the director of the 10-time FFCC Cadet Class Champion Seminole Middle School Winter Guard and has had WGI World Championship finalists at every level of competition in both scholastic and independent classes. In 2018, Mr. Smith had the honor of being inducted into the FFCC Hall of Fame.

Mr. Smith, while retired from day to day pageantry instruction, remains busy in the pageantry arts. He is an active marching band adjudicator and clinician. He serves on the board of the Florida Federation of Color Guards Circuit and is on the WGI announcing staff for regionals and World Championships. Currently, Mr. Smith is in his 28th year in public education.
